	Neighborhood/Area	Brief Summary of Petition Request
1	Oldhouse Run	Request that Oldhouse Run remain in the Godwin attendance zone.
2	Gates Head	Request that Gates Head remain in the Godwin attendance zone.
3	Gates Head, Candlewood, Springtree	Request that Gates Head, Candlewood, Springtree remain in the Godwin attendance zone.
4	Rockstone (Homeowners Assoc.)	Request that Rockstone remain in the Godwin attendance zone.
5	Raintree and Gayton Forest	Oppose boundary adjustments that divide community into separate schools. Request to remain unified in the Pemberton, Byrd, and Godwin school districts.
6	Dunncroft	Supports an option where children of Dunncroft will remain at Echo Lake. Supports elementary Plan D, opposes elementary Plan A.
7	Seven Pines	Wish to keep the Seven Pines area in the Varina school district.
8	Hartley Plantation, Winterberry	Want neighborhoods to be included in redistricting options that keep them with surrounding neighborhoods throughout elementary, middle and high school. Do not want students to travel down Nuckols Road.
9	Hartley Plantation, Winterberry, Summerberry, Springfield Manor	Want neighborhoods to be included in redistricting options that keep them with surrounding neighborhoods throughout elementary, middle and high school. Do not want students to travel down Nuckols Road.
10	Canterbury and Kingsley	Wish to keep Canterbury/Kingsley in the Godwin attendance zone. Request that high school districts remain unchanged in areas where communities are not undergoing rapid housing development.
11	Old Glen Allen Community	Supports middle school Plan A and high school Plan A. Asks that old Glen Allen community stay together and be sent to Hungary Creek and High School #1.
12	Fairfield Green	Want to remain in the Godwin attendance zone.
13	Queen's Pointe	Opposes high school Plan C. Wants to remain in the Godwin attendance zone.
14	Monumental Floral Gardens	Oppose changes to current school assignments. Want to remain at Crestview, Tuckahoe Middle, and Freeman.

15	Westwood	Oppose changes to current school assignments. Want to remain at Crestview, Tuckahoe Middle, and Freeman.
16	Crown Grant, Westminster, Sterling	Oppose elementary Plan C. Want to remain at Short Pump Elem. or attend another school closer than Jackson Davis.
17	Cross Keys, Deep Run Manor, Coles Way, Dover Hunt (census tract 06209)	Support high school Plan A and oppose high school Plans C and D (as drawn). Want to remain at Godwin.
18	Tall Timbers/Tall Oaks/The Glens	Request that Tall Timbers, Tall Oaks, and The Glens be sent to Glen Allen Elementary, Hungary Creek Middle and the New High School #1. Support high school Plans C and D, and Plan A with modifications that remove the area north of I-295 and west of Staples Mill Road and use Hungary Road and the rail road tracks as the south/central boundary. Support eastern boundary lines in middle school Plans A, C, D and E, and oppose Plan B. Support all elementary Plans.
19	Tuckahoe Village	Request that the School Board leave the portion of Tuckahoe Village north of Patterson Avenue in the Godwin High School zone.
20	Pinedale Farms	Request that Pinedale Farms remain in the Douglas Freeman High School zone. Believe that effort should be made to keep high school districts unchanged in “mature” areas of Henrico.
21	Sadler Glen, Sadler Green, Sadler Grove, Sadler Place (parents of)	Support elementary Plan D that keeps the neighborhoods in the Rivers Edge zone. Support a modification to middle school Plan D that places these neighborhoods within the boundaries of the new middle school on Nuckols Road. Support high school Plan C. Believe that Shady Grove and Rivers Edge should feed the new middle school, and Colonial Trail and Twin Hickory should feed Short Pump Middle School.
22	Sadler Glen, Sadler Green, Sadler Grove, Sadler Place (students of)	Support elementary Plan D that keeps the neighborhoods in the Rivers Edge zone. Support a modification to middle school Plan D that places these neighborhoods within the boundaries of the new middle school on Nuckols Road. Support high school Plan C. Believe that Shady Grove and Rivers Edge should feed the new middle school, and Colonial Trail and Twin Hickory should feed Short Pump Middle School.

23	Crawford Park, Willow Gate (parents of)	Support elementary Plan D that keeps the neighborhoods in the Rivers Edge zone. Request a middle school alternative that places these neighborhoods within the boundaries of the new middle school on Nuckols Road. Support high school Plan C. Favors having all Rivers Edge students attend the new middle school and all Colonial Trail students attend Short Pump Middle School.
24	Crawford Park, Willow Gate (students of)	Support elementary Plan D that keeps the neighborhoods in the Rivers Edge zone. Request a middle school alternative that places these neighborhoods within the boundaries of the new middle school on Nuckols Road. Support high school Plan C. Favors having all Rivers Edge students attend the new middle school and all Colonial Trail students attend Short Pump Middle School.
25	Barony Woods, Oak Run, Morgan Run	Oppose high school Plan C. Godwin High School is geographically more desirable. Opposes separation from Church Run and attending Jackson Davis Elementary. Want children in these neighborhoods to attend Short Pump Elementary, Pocahontas Middle, and Godwin High.
26	Church Run	Supports plans that place Church Run in the Short Pump Elementary, Pocahontas Middle, and Godwin High School attendance zones. Elementary Plans C & D, middle Plans A & D, and high school Plan A support this feeder alignment. A redistricting position paper was submitted with the petition.
27	The Cedars of Innsbrook (residents and students)	Support elementary Plan D that keeps the neighborhood in the Rivers Edge zone. Request a middle school alternative that places the neighborhood within the boundaries of the new middle school on Nuckols Road. Request that all Rivers Edge students attend the new middle school. Support high school Plan C and wish to remain at Deep Run.
28	Olde Springfield	Want a feeder pattern option that keeps Springfield Park together and feeding into Hungary Creek as Hungary Creek is more of a neighborhood school for this area. Prefer high school Plan A that utilizes 295 and Broad as boundaries. Plan C results in an unfavorable three-way split for Springfield Park students.

29	Old Glen Allen Community	Supports both elementary plans and both high school plans selected as of 2/9/09. Middle Plan D disrupts feeder patterns of both high school plans being considered. Only middle Plan A has alignment in this area. Greenwood and Glen Allen Elementary students are involved in the same community groups (outside school). Middle Plan A keeps these students together (does not use the railroad tracks as divider).
30	Maybeury Community	Supports middle school Plan A that assigns Maybeury students to Tuckahoe Middle School and Freeman High School. Wants the Maybeury students to follow a consistent feeder plan through middle and high school.
31	Sunset Hills, Neighbors of Census Tract 03611	Demand that Census Tract 03611 remain at Tuckahoe Middle School and be removed from the proposed Brookland Middle School district scenario as contemplated by middle school Plan A.
32	Wyndham Forest	Supports high school Plan C or modifying high school Plan A to allow the Wyndham Forest neighborhoods to remain at Deep Run High School.
33	Sherbrooke	Request that Sherbrooke remain at Short Pump Elementary School.
34	Woodberry I, Woodberry II, Green Springs	Want option created that keeps Springfield Park feeding entirely into Hungary Creek. Of current high school proposals, prefer Plan A which has them attending new school.
35	Charles Glen	Want to remain at Crestview, Tuckahoe Middle School and Freeman High School. Oppose middle school change to Moody and/or Brookland. Oppose high school change to Tucker High School.
36	Twin Hickory Homeowners Association, Inc.	Supports plans that allow all Twin Hickory subdivisions that currently attend Twin Hickory Elementary to attend Short Pump Middle School. This includes Willows Bend and Jamerson Park.
37	Mooreland Farms, West River, River Road Farms, Foxchapel, Dorset Woods	Support Plan A which has all Maybeury students attending Tuckahoe Middle School and Freeman High School.
38	The Colonies	Do not support either plan as neither keeps students at Pocahontas Middle School. Request to remain at Pocahontas and Godwin.

39	Kingsbridge	Oppose proposed changes to the current feeder pattern of Maybeury, Tuckahoe, and Freeman. Request that Maybeury students continue to attend Tuckahoe and Freeman.
40	Glen Gary	Wants to keep Glen Gary in the current attendance zones. Supports all first draft plans for elementary, middle and high schools as they do this.
41	Carrington/Meadows of Carrington	Parents of children in these subdivisions are adamantly against re-zoning their neighborhoods from Hungary Creek to the new middle school for reasons related to transportation, safety, proximity, community, walk-ability, parent involvement and extracurricular activities.
42	Carrington/Meadows of Carrington	Parents of children in these subdivisions are adamantly against re-zoning their neighborhoods from Echo Lake to Springfield Park Elementary School for reasons related to transportation, safety, proximity, community, walk-ability, and changes in the options presented at the first public input meetings.
43	Varina High School District	Petition to keep Seven Pines in the Varina School District signed by Varina High School Students.
44	Pinedale Farms	Residents want to remain at their current schools—Jackson Davis, Tuckahoe Middle, and Douglas Freeman. Remaining at Douglas Freeman is the area’s primary concern. Believe that every effort should be made to keep school districts unchanged in the “mature” areas of the county where development is not an issue.
45	Census tract 10614, including Hartley Plantation, Winterberry/Summerberry, Springfield Manor	Strongly support pairing #1. Springfield Road is not a good divider. The neighborhoods of Carrington, Springfield Farms, Hartley Plantation, Spring Creek/ Kings Forest, Winterberry/Summerberry, Springfield Manor should stay together at Echo Lake Elementary. The petition sites capacity, proximity, and transportation issues.

52	Fox Hall, The Colonies, Millhaven, Northbrooke, Burgundy Parke, Hardings Trace, Granville South, Tyverton, Gayton Station, Sedgemoor Oaks, Gayton Park, Graham Meadows	Supports Option 2 because it promotes feeder pattern continuity over distance. Already together in elementary and middle, allows students from these neighborhoods to stay together at Godwin as well as minimizes overcrowding at Godwin as compared to Option 1.
53	Staples Mill Trace	Requests a change to the current proposals to allow the subdivision to remain at Hungary Creek Middle School and attend Glen Allen High School. The area is open to changing elementary schools to meet these objectives.
54	Scotsglen and Avery Green	Support Pairing 1 which keeps the Twin Hickory community together at the middle school level, or support Pairing 2 being modified to include Scotsglen and Avery Green in the boundary for SPMS.
55	Cedar Station	Appreciates the redistricting efforts and agrees with the vote taken by the committee for each of the pairing options. Residents support the proposed school assignments of Short Pump Elementary, Pocahontas, and Godwin for their subdivision.
