

**Redistricting Project for 2010
Elementary Redistricting Committee Meeting Minutes
December 15, 2008**

5:30 pm – 6:00 pm. - Committee members arrived.

6:00pm. – 6:30 pm. - Cropper GIS gave an overview of the community input forums. Maps of each scenario will be available for the community to view and provide input. A questionnaire will be available for the community to write down their input for each option. After the meeting, Cropper GIS will input the data and quantify what types of feedback were provided, in order to give the committee feedback on what needs to be revised in each Draft Option.

Cropper GIS will also draft a FAQ sheet for committee members to help answer questions that may be asked by the community.

Mr. Cropper also gave an overview of the feedback group. Three groups have been created consisting of 66 to 67 committee applicants. These groups are there to listen and document what type of feedback is being discussed around the maps by the community. Each feedback committee member will receive a questionnaire that will be used to document this feedback. After each meeting, CropperGIS will again quantify this data for the committee to assist in further option edits.

Cropper GIS and the Assistant Superintendent then answered questions about the feedback group.

Mr. Cropper also stressed to the present community members that all option maps are strictly DRAFT and are still in the creation process.

6:30pm. – 8:15pm. - Cropper GIS made minor adjustments to the option maps to help balance each proposed boundary's projected capacity. The option maps were renamed to A, B, C and D in order to reduce any confusion with past options. The school division has taken the numbers of each boundary and provided a forecast up to 2013 showing how many students are to be expected based on each option. Cropper GIS has also worked with the boundaries to balance the numbers to meet target capacities. The school division forecasted membership to "buildout" for each scenario. The committee members decided to present membership to 2013, not buildout.

****The group decided to take the Build Out column out of the projection spreadsheet in order to reduce confusion, as the timeline for buildout cannot be exactly determined.**

The group then focused their attention to Option A. The first area under examination was Echo Lake. The group decided on an area in the southern portion of Echo Lake that has 110 kids that

could potentially be added to the Longan attendance boundary. The committee decided that Francistown Road would be a good boundary to split the Echo Lake boundary.

The next area of focus was the Pemberton/Pinchbeck boundaries. The group focused on the Gaskins road area and the committee discussed how this area could be changed to balance Pemberton's overcapacity by reassigning to Pinchbeck.

Greenwood ES was the next area of focus. The committee agreed that an area with 78 kids could be taken out of Trevvett and be reassigned to Greenwood to balance these numbers.

Skipwith was the next area of focus.

Due to time constraints the group decided to move to Option B. The first area was Greenwood. The committee pointed out an area where 100 kids could be shifted in the south from Greenwood to Trevvett.

The next area was Ridge. The committee debated how to balance the Davis, Skipwith, and Ridge areas. There are 9 kids that could be moved from Skipwith to Davis.

The next area was Skipwith. The group debated taking kids from Skipwith and moving to Davis. The group decided to move 46 kids from Skipwith to Davis.

The group then moved to Option C. The first area of focus was Dumbarton. The group debated how to edit Echo Lake and Glen Allen in order to reduce membership of Dumbarton. The group decided to move 65 from Dumbarton to Glen Allen.

The next area was Ridge. The group agreed to move 82 kids from Ridge and assign to Pinchbeck.

The group then moved to Option D. The first area of focus was Colonial Trail. The group decided to leave the northwestern area as TBD. The group agreed to move 58 from Dumbarton to Longan.

The group decided to take 33 kids from Three Chopt to Crestview and then move 29 from Skipwith to Three Chopt. In addition, the group decided to take an additional 79 students from Skipwith and move to Three Chopt.

The next area of focus was Ridge. The group decided to move 47 students from Ridge into Tuckahoe.
