

**Redistricting Project for 2010  
High School Committee Meeting Minutes  
December 17, 2008**

5:30pm – 6:00pm. - Committee members arrived.

6:00pm – 6:15pm. - Matt Cropper gave an overview of the community input forums. Maps of each scenario will be available for the community to view and provide input. A questionnaire will be available for the community to write down their input for each option. After the meeting, Cropper GIS will input the data and quantify what types of feedback was provided, in order to give the committee feedback on what needs to be revised in each Draft Option.

Cropper GIS will also draft a FAQ sheet for committee members to help answer questions that may be asked by the community.

Matt Cropper also gave an overview of the feedback group. Three groups have been created consisting of 66 to 67 committee applicants. These groups are there to listen and document what type of feedback is being discussed around the maps by the community. Each feedback committee member will receive a questionnaire that will be used to document this feedback. After each meeting, CropperGIS will again quantify this data for the committee to assist in further option edits.

Cropper GIS then answered questions about the feedback group.

Matt Cropper also stressed to the present community members that all option maps are strictly DRAFT and are still in the creation process.

6:15pm – 8:30pm. - Cropper GIS has made adjustments to the option maps. The current five options have been renamed to A, B, C, D, and E. The school division has taken the numbers of each boundary and provided a forecast up to 2013 showing how many students are to be expected based on each option. Cropper GIS has also worked with the boundaries to balance the numbers to meet target capacities. The school division forecasted membership to “buildout” for each scenario. The committee members decided to present membership to 2013, not buildout.

**\*\* The group decided to take the Buildout column out of the projection spreadsheet in order to reduce confusion, as the timeline for buildout cannot be exactly determined.**

The group then decided to look at each scenario in more detail beginning with Option A. The first area of focus was Deep Run and Godwin. The group agreed that two areas north of Godwin HS could be assigned to Godwin. Next, the group agreed that an area in Godwin, containing 27 kids could be reassigned to Freeman. The group then agreed that an area with 50

students north of Freeman could be reassigned from Tucker to Freeman.

The next area of focus was the New HS. The group agreed to move 91 kids from New HS to Hermitage in the southern area. The group then agreed to move 12 kids in the eastern region from the New HS to Hermitage.

The next area of focus was Highland Springs and Varina. The group then agreed to take 70 kids out of Varina and put them into Highland Springs in the northern area. The group also agreed to take 99 kids from Varina to Highland Springs.

The group then decided to remove Option B as a draft scenario because of it's similarity to Option A.

The group then decided to move to Option C. The group decided to move roughly 80 kids out of Highland Springs into Henrico. The group then changed focus to Deep Run HS and Godwin. The group decided to split a census tract by putting 66 from Gayton Station into Deep Run and 253 kids from Foxhall to Godwin. The group also agreed to move 135 students from the New HS into Tucker.

The group then moved to Option D. Looking at Highland Springs the group decided to move students from Highland Springs into Henrico. The group agreed to move 67 students from Varina into Highland Springs. Next the group moved their focus to Henrico. The group agreed to move 70 students from Hermitage to Henrico. The group then agreed to move 134 students from Tucker back into Hermitage. The group then decided to move students from Deep Run to the New HS. The group also decided to take 215 students from Deep Run into Godwin.

The group then moved to Option E and decided to remove option E as the committee felt three options (A, C, D) provided enough variations for consideration. Based on committee consensus A, C, and D are the only options that will go to the community forum. The options were not renamed by the committee.
