6:10p- Mr. Cropper gave an overview of the community input forums. Maps of each scenario will be available for the community to view and provide input. A questionnaire will be available for the community to write down their input for each option.

Matt also gave an overview of the feedback group. Three groups have been created consisting of 66 to 67 committee applicants. These groups are there to listen and document what type of feedback is being given by the committee.

All maps and tables in the future will continue to have a DRAFT watermark on them to avoid anxiety.

6:30p- Cropper GIS has made adjustments to the option maps. The current five options have been renamed to A, B, C, D, and E. The school division has taken the numbers of each boundary and provided a forecast up to 2013 showing how many students are to be expected based on each option. Cropper GIS has also worked with the boundaries to balance the numbers to meet target capacities. The school division forecasted membership to “buildout” for each scenario. The committee members decided to present membership to 2013, not buildout

****Based on committee consensus, the Build Out column in the projection tables will be removed to reduce confusion, as the timeline for buildout cannot be exactly determined.**

The group then began to discuss each option in detail, beginning with Option A. The first area of focus in Option A was Short Pump. The first concern with Short Pump’s boundary was how far east this boundary extends.

The second area of focus was Pocahontas. No concerns were expressed as this boundary has not changed from the current.

The third area of focus was Byrd.

The fourth area of focus was Tuckahoe.

The fifth area of focus was Brookland. There were no concerns.

The sixth area of focus was Hungary Creek. There was a concern that this area was previously redistricted and with this option it has been split again into 3 different areas.

The seventh area of focus was Moody.

The eighth area of focus was Wilder. There were no concerns with this boundary.

The ninth area of focus was Fairfield. There were no concerns with this boundary.

The tenth area of focus was Elko.

The eleventh area of focus was Rolfe. The only concern was the south end. Although concerns were discussed, the committee decided to leave option A, B, C, and E unchanged.

The group then moved their focus back to Option D and made revisions.

The group concluded that they will move forward with Options A through E to the community forum, including the edits made to Option D.
